



We urge you to send for your certificate early as it takes two weeks to process.



More years ago than we'd like to count, a group of slightly crazy women called themselves the "Rowdi Bunch" and Rowdi Arabians was born from a single Crabbet line foundation mare. After a long hiatus from breeding, the winds of opportunity began to blow again and like the fabled phoenix, Rowdi Arabians rose again.

Our present partnership seems destined. Our small, select band all came to us out of obscurity or misfortune. Queene (Handyraff granddaughter) was rescued from a local "killer" sale. Miki Wind (Wind Fortune x An Malik daughter) was once sold for a board bill and came to us from a divorce sale. Rowdi Mani-tou (Cytrys granddaughter x Crabbet mare) was the last filly bred by the original Rowdi Arabians. Rowdi Sorcerer (owned by Ginger Graybill), the sire of our 96 colts, is the last son of Antezeyn Skowronek.

This year, we were given the opportunity to lease a superb 97% Crabbet Lewisfield blood stallion, SCF Magic Nizzam from Mrs. Barbara Gould, Spring Creek Arabians. who was unable to promote Zam to his full potential. He is probably the last breeding stallion so close in blood to Indian Magic and Nizzam, two Crabbet legends, and the son of a National Champion. He may be the last source of straight Lewisfield blood available.

Our breeding goal: supreme athletes, with knock-emdead classic looks and real "tent-horse" personalities. We invite you to come by and hug all our horses!

The great Gulastra 521 died before his last batch of foals arrived in 1955. Left among his legacy was a chestnut colt foaled on June 7, out of Al-Marah Aasaba 5352, "one of our best Indraff 1575 daughters," states breeder Bazy Tankersly in some old correspondence regarding the mare. The colt was originally named Al-Marah Anmar, which is Arabic for 'patriarch.' The name was later changed to Roh Beta Gulastra, after his purchase in the 1956 Al Marah Auction by Dr. Roger Baker, who was "Jack Armstrong - The All American Boy" of radio fame.

Roh Beta Gulastra's bloodlines are a rare and wonderful blend of Crabbet stock descending from old Egyptian sources of Ali Pasha and the desert tribes of Egypt. He was considered 61/64's Al Khamsa. His pedigree also reveals a great deal of athletic ability.

Sire and Dam

Roh Beta Gulastra's sire, Gulastra, was bred by W.R. Brown, Maynesboro Stud, Berlin, NH, and foaled May 21, 1924. Gulastra lived to the ripe old age of 31 and sired 115 registered foals which was a large number of foals for those days. Gulastra sired horses all over the United States, and this chestnut's last home was with Bazy Tankersly of Al-

Marah Arabians. Gulastra's sire, *Astraled 238, was bred at Crabbet Park Stud in England, and imported at the age of nine in 1909 by F. Lathrop Ames. *Astraled was the sire of *Ramla 357, winner of the 306 miles long Endurance Test of 1919 for the U.S. Mounted Service Cup, and also the sire of Kheyra 229, who placed third that same year. Gulnare 278, Gulastra's dam,

was sired by *Rodan 258, bred by Crabbet and imported in-utero in 1905 by Spencer Borden, and was out of *Ghazala 211, a grey mare bred by Ali Pasha Sherif of Egypt. *Rodan took fourth overall and High Scoring Stallion in the 154 mile Morgan Horse Club Endurance Test in 1913 with a time of 30 hours and 40 minutes, the same time as for the winner who was carrying 20 more pounds than *Rodan.

The dam of Roh Beta Gulastra, Al-Marah Aasaba 5352, was sired by Bazy Tankersly's highly regarded foundation sire Indraff 1575 who was of Crabbet descent (*Raffles 952 x *Indaia 813), and out of Nafri 2010, a daughter of the great Egyptian racehorse *Nasr 889, who stood at stud at the world famous Manial Stud in Cairo prior to being imported to the U.S. by W.R. Brown.

Changing Owners

They say "like father like son" and Roh Beta Gulastra sired horses all over the United States as did his father before him. After Dr. Roger Baker left the Arabian horse business, Roh Beta Gulastra was sold. It is difficult to account for all of Roh Beta Gulastra's owners. It appears he stood in the Midwest for a time, as well as The Elephant Walk Trading

Company in Pleasant Valley, NY, for a \$1000 stud fee from 1975 through 1979.

Howard Marks of Tracy, CA, had owned Gulastra in his later years prior to Bazy Tankersly in 1953. As part of that same circle of life, Marks purchased Roh Beta Gulastra sight unseen in 1982. In a brief article appearing in the 1984 January Arabian Horse World, Marks felt Roh Beta Gulastra "Looked so much like his sire that it was just like the old horse comin' home." The article was written when Roh Beta Gulastra was 29, and it goes on to say that "Whenever a mare comes by, he starts prancing and showing off and is very masculine." Roh Beta Gulastra's antique bloodlines blended nicely with the Crabbet/ Egyptian mares of Howard Marks, producing some very nice stock that is still breeding today.

In the fall of 1984, Robbi Pruitt (then living in California) was looking for a stallion to breed to her mare. While leafing through a magazine, she read an adfor a son of Gulastra at the Howard Marks Ranch in Northern California; it was Roh Beta Gulastra. "When I called the ranch to inquire about breeding," says Pruitt, "I was told that the stallion was for sale and probably would not be available next

season." Pruitt wasted little time and added the grand old man, Roh Beta Gulastra, to her herd along with "two beautiful HMR bred mares and a weanling son of the old stallion."

Roh Beta Gulastra became affectionately known as "RB" and he lived out his days with Robbi Pruitt until he died at the age of 33. Pruitt, a breeder dedicated to preserving

the antique desert Arabian blood, crossed RB onto her CMK mares, retaining several of them as breeding stock for her herd.

Roh Beta Gulastra Endurance Sire

RB sired a total of 82 registered purebred foals beginning in 1960 until his last ones hit the ground in 1988. Again, like his father before him, his final foal crop left behind the very horse that may continue where he left off. Robbi Pruitt's stallion Gulastras Splash, out of Djomaca, is a beautifully balanced chestnut with plenty of chrome, including a belly spot. He is rapidly proving himself as a successful endurance horse, having over 1500 miles, ranking 3rd Mileage Stallion in the United States in 1994, plus placing in the Top 10 and winning best condition. Splash has also been introduced to dressage. Splash's first foals, all chestnuts, show great athleticism and have good dispositions. Longtime Arab breeder Marjorie Van Gilder of Wasco, OR loves her Splash filly out of Sholex, and she was so thrilled with this filly that she bred the mare back to Splash, hoping for another "just like her."

RB, like his sire Gulastra and also his grandsires *Astraled and *Rodan, was noted for siring athletic performance horses. Quite a few of RB's later foals bred by Robbi Pruitt have gone on to be successful endurance horses. "It was a great feeling," Pruitt told me, "to see five RB descendants that I bred going down the trail on the Death Valley Encounter." The Death Valley Encounter is an AERC multi-day ride of 210 miles in four days and was held late December 1995.

RB's son, HMR Striko, a bay stallion out of HMR Bint Shiko, got off to a promising start, completing 200 miles in American Endurance Ride Conference (AERC) sanctioned rides prior to a pasture injury, the result of getting a leg over a pipe rail fence. HMR Striko also has a couple offspring beginning endurance careers. Gulastras Echo, a chestnut stallion out of Queen Lawruska, is nearing 1000 miles carrying heavyweight rider, Gary Rexroad. The RB daughters, HMR Waulastra out of HMR Wautal, and CR Bezt Chablis out of Ms Bezt, have been tested in endurance before becoming broodmares. Gailastra, a grey gelding out of Gai Andromeda and owned by Kathy Murphy, has performed well in endurance on rides of 50-100 miles by placing in the Pacific Northwest Endurance Rides Top 25 and AERC Northwest Region standings for 1995. CR Cajuns Bezt, out of Ms Bezt and owned by David Allen, has approximately 500 miles down the trail. Gulastras Sundown, a chestnut gelding out of HMR Hariba is owned by Al and Karen Paulo (this writer). He started his endurance career in 1995, having only 100 miles to his credit, and shows a lot of future promise.

It looks as though the athleticism from the desert will continue to trickle into the future through Roh Beta Gulastra and his offspring.



As I wish to remain a small breeding operation I am now offering most of my mares for sale. All mares are either bred for 1997 or come with a free breeding to FV Shizam, a beautifully built linebred *Nasik horse who is by the spectacular moving Aurab son, Aur Shibui, who is out of Jada Sierra. Jada Sierras' grandparents are Rabiyas, Rayza by Ghazi, Sharik by Ralet and Nasina who is by *Nasik out of *Farasin. CENTENARY OF THE HARWOOD STUD

Harwood has the distinction of being the oldest Arabian stud in Britain. It was founded in 1896 when Colonel F. Lyon of Horsham, Sussex, bought the four year-old mare Howa at the 8th Crabbet Sale. Howa was a great-granddaughter of the Blunt's well-known mare Hagar, which they bought in Arabia and rode on their desert journeys, and her sire was Azrek, one of the Blunt's finest imports. Howa's granddam, Harik, was Hagar's daughter by Kars, the first stallion to stand at Crabbet and Wilfrid Blunt's favourite hunter.

After the first World War Colonel Lyon's daughter May and son Alec took over the Stud. May Lyon, a great admirer of Lady Anne Blunt and a staunch supporter of Lady Wentworth, later added several other mares of Crabbet breeding to Howa's family. These included Yavroum (1944) by the famous Raktha out of Nazziria, a rare Naziri daughter; Rafika (1943) by Ruskov out of Rishna; and two valuable Indian Gold daughters, Rosalina (1943) out of Rissella, and Naxindra (1944) out of Naxina. These mares provided the foundation of the Harwood Stud.

Alec Lyon had a property at Rostrevor, beautifully situated on the shores of Carlingford Bay in Ireland, and some of the horses lived there. On his death they passed to May who continued the Stud with horses at both places and she lived for half the year in Ireland and half at Harwood.

Unfortunately Miss Lyon's ideas of stud management were virtually non existant. Pasture was neglected, the horses were never wormed and their general condition often poor. Miss Lyon died in 1962 and she left her Horsham estate to her first cousin's son, Robert Calvert and his wife Monica, and the Irish property and the horses there to their youngest daughter, Georgie (now Mrs Moore), who was twelve at the time.

The Calverts immediately set about re-organising the Stud. Hop Oast Farm, just outside Horsham, was purchased and Robbie and Monica Calvert bought from Georgie the horses at Rostrevor and re-united them as one stud on the new property. The farm consists of 250 acres altogether, of which 75 acres are well fenced paddocks; there is woodland and forestry land through which they ride. Cattle are grazed in the summer months and the Calverts make some of their own hay.

The Brick built buildings were converted into stabling, and barns into three covered yards for young foals. Wooden sectional stables house most of the brood mares. Four other wooden loose boxes have two entrances and small paddocks attached and these make excellent accommodation for stallions and newly weaned foals. The indoor school was blown down in the 1987 hurricane and this has been replaced by an outdoor menage.

Having settled in the horses at the new location the Calverts learned all they could about stud management. The horses were properly fed and cared for and their general condition rapidly improved.

Harwood Achievements are Many

The aim of the Harwood Stud is to produce Arabians of a high standard which are capable of performance work. Their horses have taken part in a great variety of events including the Golden Horseshoe Long

Distance Ride, the Arab Horse Society Marathon Race over 26 1/4 miles, the Ride and Tie and ridden show classes, all with considerable success and many wins.

Their main interest, however, is in racing and there are usually one or two Arabians in training. One of their best has been Miralda, by Kasadi out of Mariamne. After a distinguished career on the race-course, during which she won three times and had a very consistent record in the Qatar Mares Championship with two seconds, a third and a fourth, she is now a successful brood mare. In fact, Miranda proved that it is possible for mares to alternate the role of broodmare and racehorse as she had her first foal at the age of four in 1986, then raced for three years, had a year off to produce her second foal in 1990 and then returned to racing for another two seasons before finally retiring to stud. Gentian (Genaro ex Jacynth) also raced well for a couple of seasons and came second to her stable companion in one race in 1987. She also is proving her worth as a broodmare and has a daughter Gennista, by Sha'baan, running in 1996.

Georgie Moore trains the race horses at her home nearby, and her husband John used to be jockey. Currently the Stud Groom, Joe Norman, is stable jockey whilst his wife, Sue, does much of the in-hand showing. Harwood has a happy family atmosphere where the emphasis is on busy enjoyment of all the activities with everyone joining in.


Stallions Used at Harwood

When the Calverts inherited the Stud the principle stallions, Magnet (Dargee ex Rosalina and Fancy Shadow (Bright Shadow ex Yavroum) were quite old and following Miss Lyon's tradition of breeding from Crabbet horses, they decided to purchase a colt from Cecil Covey, who then owned the Crabbet Stud. They chose Indian Flame II, by Indian Magic out of Nerinora; he won at two or three major shows and proved a successful sire. His son, Taqah, out of Angelica (who is of the valuable Queen of Sheba line) sired a number of very good horses before his exportation to Qatar. Kasadi, by Taqah out of Anna Rose, who traces to Rissla, is now continuing this important line and has sired top-class show winning stock, as well as race and performance winners.

In 1984 the Calverts purchased Sha'baan (Shakhs ex Kasbana) to introduce an outcross. Occasionally a mare is sent to an outside stallion but to get new blood a stallion is often leased for a season or two. Currently Saker (Ahmoun ex Moulton Star) who was British National Champion Colt in 1988 and then raced successfully, is on lease at Harwood.

Sufficient carefully selected fillies are retained to keep up the required number of brood mares, approximately twelve. Surplus colts and fillies are sold as breeding stock and for riding, and some of the colts are gelded, the Calverts believing that geldings that do well in open competition are some of the best ambassadors for the breed.


There are certain female lines which the Calverts especially wish to preserve in the stud. They are particularly anxious to retain the line from Rissla through Rosalina, which they call their "Rose" family; another line they value is that of Mariamne, who descends from Rafika. Their lovely mare Sophy, by Hücklebury Fynn out of Nigella, a granddaughter of the Blue Domino mare Blue Sophonisba bought in by the Calverts, is one of the most consistent show mares in the country. She has won or been highly placed at most of the major shows and in 1988 was Champion at the South of England Show as a three-year-old. Two years later she was Champion Brood Mare at the British National Show at Malvern.

Robbie and Monica Calvert became deeply interested in the Stud and in all matters connected with Arabians. They raised Harwood to be one of the foremost studs in the country and respected for the versatility of its horses. Monica, a Past-President of the Arab Horse Society and now a Governor, supervised the day to day management and has run the Stud alone since Robbie died in 1987. Georgie Moore and her family are equally enthusiastic so it looks as though the Harwood Stud will continue as a family affair well into its second century. It is hoped that a One Day "Foundation Review" for Arabians of Old English bloodlines will be held at Harwood in the summer of 1997.





The Crabbet Influence in Dutch **Arabian Breeding** Part Two: In Between Years By Monique Lankhaar

In 1948 Dr. Houtappel imported the stallions Nizzam (Rissam x Nezma) who needs no introduction to American Crabbet breeders, and the The Chief (Riffal x Astrella, a full brother to Oran). He also imported the mares Sulka (Naseem x Nurschida), Tehoura (Radi x Niseyra) and Ziada (Fayal x Raxina). Nizzam and The Chief were both registered as bay, the mares Tehoura and Sulka were chestnuts and Ziada was a grey. Dr. Houtappel did not object against Skowronek, most of the horses he imported carried Skowronek's blood in one or more lines. They were all used on Dr. Houtappel's Rodania Stud for breeding. Their descendents can still be found in Europe and abroad. From Tehoura's offspring must be mentioned Bashida by General Grant, foaled 1952. Bashida still appears in the pedigrees of Dutch Arabians, more about her later on. Also must be mentioned Hamad (by The Chief), foaled 1953, who left some lovely offspring. And of course Achim by Noran, foaled 1961, probably Tehoura's most famous son and the only foal she had by Noran.

Sulka also had some very nice offspring, three daughters and a son the famous Nizar by Nizzam. Nizar was sold to Mr. Doemken of Germany, were he had major influence on the German Arab breed.

From Nizzam two other sons were of great influence on Dutch Arab breeding. Namely Aatik out of Farida who was by Edh Dhahab x Sulka and Nisry out of Rythoura (Rythal x Tehoura).

In 1959 Dr. Houtappel bought Noran at Crabbet Park. Noran became one of the most influential stallions in the Netherlands not to the least through his son Achim. In 1969 Achim went to Great Britain with Dr. Houtappel, he was forced to move because a motor way was going to be built across his land. There Achim was Supreme Male Champion in 1973 and Reserve European Champion in 1980. Later on he went to Mrs. Bazy Tankersley of Al Marah Arabians in the U.S.A.

During the sixties there were some other people who also imported Arabians from Great Britain. Among them were Mrs. H. De Ruiter Van Eyndthoven, Mrs. A. Peletier-Muller and Prof. Dr. and Mrs. A Moonen. Some of the horses they imported were the mares Susquehanna (General Grant x Raggassa) and Shakra (Indian Magic x Rissada) and the stallion Rissaz (Indriss x Kazra), he was bred at the Maxwell's Lodge Farm. They all created their own families in Holland. The stallion Rissaz was exported to Italy a few years ago, and nobody has heard of him since. Maybe he died, because he was not that young anymore. One of his sons still breeds in Holland, a grey named Oostervelds Marzas.

Unfortunately not many descendents from the early imports are left in Holland. Mainly because the Russian Arabs were introduced to Holland. And many people sold their English bred Arabs or bred them to/with a Russian Arab. You might say that the Dutch invented the Crabbet Russian cross. Many Arabs of these crosses were highly placed at shows. To name just a few of the stallions: Hassan and Khouros by Plakat out of the mare Chantal (Fancy Shadow x Mafika). And of course the stallion Amal by Abdullah out of Naomi (Darjeel x Zelda). The English lines were so bred out of the Dutch Arabs, although you can still find Arabs in Holland with one or more lines to either the early imports or to Crabbet Arabs who were imported to other countries in the world. Also a lot of people discovered the Polish Arabs and switched from the English lines to the Polish Arabs. The Moonen family, for example, only breeds Polish Arabs nowadays.




The Breeding Program at Diamond L Arabians



On The Importance of Good Photos by Sandy Rolland Clark

The importance of good photos cannot be stressed enough. I'm sure that you have been taught all you life how important first impressions are. Well, a photo of your horse is a first impression, and if it isn't a decent photo, there will most probably be no chance to correct this impression.

As a historian I have been forced to use some truly awful photos because that is simply all there is in existence. This gives us the euphoric feeling that our horses today are better quality. But are they really? Or is it just extremely poor photos that make this appear to be the case? As historians, one hopes we may be forgiven for using a bad photo for its historical value to preserve a record of the horse, but there is no excuse for a bad photo of a horse that is still living and one can do something to get a decent photo.

In today's market, the newcomer to the Arab horse is assaulted by "pure this" and "straight that" and they tend to "judge a book by its cover."

When you send photos to this, or any other publication, they need to be sharp, clear photos. If you are taking your own photos, I will say a word here about film. Black and white film works best if the photo is to be reproduced in black and white because the contrast is sharper - the film is designed that way. Photos taken on film with an ASA rating higher than 200 may look fine in a standard size print, but when it is enlarged it will be "grainy" and start to blur.

A regular 50 mm lens that comes standard with most cameras is not appropriate for horse photography. It tends to make the horse's muzzle look larger since it is nearer to the lens and also makes the top of the head appear small. Therefore it's best to use a 35 mm camera with a long distance lens or zoom lens. This way the distortion is minimized with the added depth of field a long distance lens provides. Of course you will be forced to stand further away from your subject, but for accuracy's sake, the lens will show the horse in focus while putting a soft edge on background and foreground objects.

Amateur vs. professional. There is nothing wrong with a good amateur photo as long as it is well thought out and well done. Bay horses tend to blend into the background when posed in front of trees - especially if reproduced in black and white from a color photo. A grey horse will do a Cheshire Cat act when posed in front of a white barn. So use some common "horse sense" when choosing your background: dark horse in front of a light background and light horse in front of a dark background.

The human eye only sees what it is focused on, unlike the eye of the camera, which will record everything in front of it. So, while YOU are looking at your horse, the camera will record the telephone pole behind him that makes him look like a carousel horse and the fence that needs to be touched up with paint. Look around carefully - you will find that you didn't notice things that you see every day.

Your photo will also show the family pets wandering about!

The horse should be CLEAN with no mud or dirt on him/her. His mane and tail should be free of witches knots and his fetlocks should have been clipped of excess hair. The inside of the horse's ears and his eyelashes should never, ever be clipped. These are his protection against insects and dirt. Your tack need not be fancy, but it should be clean and in good repair.

Now you are ready to take the photo. This will take a crew of 3-4 people for best results. A handler for the horse, a camera person, and at least one other to help with "ears" and etc.


The handler should have all four of the horse's hooves on the ground, with all four of them under the horse. The far foreleg should be slightly behind the near foreleg and the far hindleg should be slightly in front of the near hindleg. The horse should be alert with his ears pricked, and if possible (I am assuming that our group of people are doing the photos NATURALLY without the use of ginger or anything else!), the tail slightly raised. Don't pull his head and neck up in the stars. This only makes it appear that the handler is holding the horse up and it distorts the neck. Please be sure the horse is standing on level ground so that he doesn't look high on one end or the other. Also be sure the handler is on the same level as the horse so the horse doesn't come across as either a pony or a "drafter!"

The photographer should stand facing the horse's barrel and hold the camera at the midpoint of the horse. This is particularly important with foal photos. If you stand above the foal you will get a distorted looking foal with a large head and small legs. Bending down to level the cameras lens on the same sight as the foals mid-section will greatly improve the dimensions of the final photo. If you stand too far in front of or behind the horse, the horse will look too light in the end away from the photographer, and/or heavy in the end near the camera.

The helper's job is to get the horse to look alert. This may be done in any number of ways and it depends a great deal on how laid back your horse is and how accustomed he is to the tricks used in the show ring. A plastic jug with rocks in it, a plastic bread wrapper tied on a whip or a stick popping in the wind, a full length mirror, etc. If it can be managed, a strange horse will make him "tighten up" prick his ears, and raise this tail. If you are going to attempt this method, a strange gelding will work best - a mare will cause your stallion to drop, which you don't want in your photo.

And finally, PLEASE FOLKS, MAKE THIS AN HONEST PHOTO OF YOUR HORSE, and not an "artsy" photo! It makes my teeth itch to see a horse cowering in a rose bush or behind a pretty girl in various garbs. It always makes one wonder what is being hidden.


